NON-Department for Education External Service Provider Policy

Elizabeth Vale School and Preschool does not permit Non-Department for Education external service providers to conduct face to face therapy sessions onsite.

Elizabeth Vale School and Preschool recommend parents/carers seek appointments from these service providers for sessions before or after school hours.

The reasoning of the school's Non-Department for Education external service provider policy:

- . Logistically complicated to manage and track many providers coming onto the school site given our student cohort and learning environment
- Administration time
- . Provision of an adequate space that complies with line of sight and duty of care
- · Additional responsibility placed on teaching and non-teaching staff in monitoring situations and students
- · Impact on student learning time

Parents/Carers/Guardians are made aware of this policy through:

- · New enrolments meetings
- · School newsletters, website, notices
- During family/parent meetings or as circumstances arise

Non-Department for Education external providers may be permitted onto the school site occasionally in a consultative capacity when:

- . Informed parental consent is provided and cited/recorded by school
- · Purpose and timing of the visit has been discussed with school staff and approval from leadership
- · Proof of registration and provider number of appropriate association is cited/recorded by school
- . Insurance indemnity and ABN has been cited/recorded by school
- · Current working with children check and RRHAN is cited/recorded by school
- · Additional to this, is proof or exemption of COVID vaccination cited


